2-1-1 Help Line

United Way's 2-1-1 Help Line handled 280,000 civilian and military callers and website visitors last year, helping local residents with health and human services information and referrals. The top four caller needs included food stamps, utility assistance, rent assistance and emergency food needs. However, assistance is available for a variety of services such as legal help, medical care, childcare, employment, and counseling/mental health. Call specialists are available 24/7/365. Online chat and an online database are also available to provide information.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA)

Last year, Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program volunteers prepared 31,000 tax returns and returned \$54 million to San Antonio residents—a real boost to local taxpayers and the economy. The city-wide VITA locations saved participants \$10 million in tax preparation fees since VITA services are free to those earning up to \$60,000 this tax year. Earned Income Tax Credits (EITC) returned to San Antonians totaled \$21 million.
